This race is conducted in memory of a man who changed the world. On August 7, 1932 - the day of the Los Angeles Olympic Marathon, he was born in Mout, Ethiopia. At 28 he ran barefooted in the 1960 Rome Olympic Marathon. would make He & his coach decided he his move 1k from the finish line the Obelisk of where the course passed Axum, a monument that was plundered from Ethiopia by Italian troops in 1935 & taken to Rome. When Bikila reached the obelisk, he pulled ahead winning by 200m in 2:15:16, making him a athletes worldnational hero, inspiring wide. Bikila ran again the 1964 Tokyo in leading by Olympic Marathon. He was more than the halfway mark, won by a world best & first 4 minutes in 2:12:11.2. 2 marathons. Affected ever competitor to win by the heat & altitude at the 1968 Mexico City Olympic Marathon, he dropped out at 17k, but 💃 countryman Mamo cheered on his fellow 🔼 1969 a car crash near Wolde to a victory. In Addis Ababa left him paralyzed from the waist down. As a wheelchair athelete he won gold medals in 1970 at 10k and 25k cross-country sledge competitions in Norway. Bikila died in Addis Ababa on October 25, 1973.
